Order for Holy Communion

Members of the Orthodox Church age seven and above must prepare for Holy Communion with a recent confession, prayer, fasting from all food and drink from midnight (unless a medical condition preclude it), being in church *before* the Epistle and Gospel readings, and being at peace with everyone.

As there are **NO CHURCH SCHOOL** classes today, children should sit with their parents and come to Communion with them. An usher will dismiss your row from the center aisle. Then return to your place by a side aisle for the prayers of thanksgiving and the final blessing and dismissal. Please let choir members pass when they come down for Communion.

A Warm Welcome to Our Guests

We are glad you are worshipping with us. Please note that participation in **Holy Communion is limited to members of the Orthodox Church** in good standing, who have prepared with prayer, fasting and a recent confession.

For all others: though we cannot share Communion with you—since it is an expression of membership and full unity in faith—you are welcome to come forward after the dismissal, receive a blessing and partake of the blessed bread (from the large bowls). Please also sign our guest book and introduce yourself to Fr. Nabil or Fr. Andrew during coffee hour. You may inquire with them how you can become a member.

SIX DAYS BEFORE THE PASSOVER. Lazarus who had died was. whom Jesus had raised from the dead. There they made him a supper; Martha served, le hicieron allí una cena; at table with Him. When the great crowd of the Iews learned that He was there, they came, not only be- taba allí, y fueron, no solacause of Jesus but also to see Lazarus, whom Jesus had raised from the dead. So the chief priests planned to put Lazarus also to death, because on account of him many of the lews were going away and believing in Jesus.

The next day a great crowd who had come to the feast heard that Iesus was coming to Jerusalem. So, they took branches of palm trees and comes in the Name of the Lord, the King of Israel!" And Iesus found a young ass and sat upon it; as it is written, "Fear not, daughter of Zion: behold, your king is coming, sitting on an ass's colt!"

His disciples did not understand this at first; but when Iesus was glorified, then they remembered that this had been written of Him and had been done to Him. The reason why the crowd went to meet Him was that they heard He had done this sign.

وعَلِمَ جَمعٌ كَثيرٌ مِنَ اليهودِ أَنَّ يسوعَ هناك، فجاؤوا، لا مِنْ أجل يسوعَ فَقَطْ، بَلْ لِيَنْظُرُوا أَيْضاً لَعازَرَ الذي أَقامَهُ مِنْ بين الأمواتِ. فَأْتَكَرَ رؤساءُ الكَهَنَةِ أَنْ يَقْتُلُوا لَعَازَرَ أيضاً، لأنَّ كثيرينَ من البَهود كانُوا بسَبَبهِ يَذهبونَ فيؤمِنونَ بيسوعَ. وفي الغَدِ، لما سَمِعَ الجَمعُ الكثيرُ الذينَ جاؤوا إلى العيدِ بأنَّ يَسوعَ آتِ إلى أُورَشَليمَ، أَخَذُوا سَعَفَ النَحْل وخَرَجُوا للقائِه وهُم يصرُخُونَ قائِلينَ: "هُوشَعْنا، مُبارَكُ الآتي باسم الرَّبّ مَلِكُ إسرائيل". وإنَّ يسوعَ وَجَدَ جَحشاً فَرَكِبَهُ كما هُوَ مكتوبٌ: "لا تَخافى يا ابْنَةَ صهيونَ. ها إِنَّ مَلِكَكِ يأتيكِ راكِباً على جَحْشٍ ابْنِ أتان".

وهذه الأشياءُ لم يَفهَمْها تَلاميذُهُ أَوَّلاً، ولكِنْ لِمَا مُجِّدَ يسوعُ حينئذٍ تَذَكَّرُوا أَنَّ هذِهِ إِنَّمَا كُتِبَتْ عَنهُ وأَنَّهم عَمِلُوها لهُ. وكانَ الجمعُ الذينَ كانُوا مَعَهُ حينَ نادى لعازَرَ مِنْ القبر وأقامَهُ مِنْ بين الأمواتِ يَشْهَدُونَ لَهُ. ومِنْ أجل هذا اسْتَقْبَلَهُ الجَمْعُ، لأنَّهُمْ سَمِعوا بأنَّهُ قَدْ صَنَعَ هذهِ الآبة.

NEW HEARING ASSISTANCE SYSTEM INSTALLED

Thanks to the generosity of a donor, we have added a hearing assistance system to the sound system that was installed in the Cathedral two years ago.

To use it,

- 1. you need to pick a receiver from the charger station at the candle stand
- 2. <u>and either</u> an earpiece <u>or</u> a loop that feeds into a hearing aid wirelessly.



If you have a compatible hearing aid

Pick up a loop, wear it around your neck, and plug both ends into the receiver.

You can just wear it like a necklace.



Pick up an earpiece, and plug it into either port on the receiver.


You can then put the receiver in a pocket.





Whether you are using the hearing aid loop or the earpiece, you can adjust the volume using the UP/DOWN buttons on the front of the receiver.





