Starting the New Year Off Right

On **Monday, January 1**, we commemorate the Circumcision of Christ, on the Eighth Day after His birth, in fulfillment of the Law, given through Moses.



We also remember St. Basil the Great with the rite of **cutting the Vasilopita**. We recall the miracle God worked through him: it involved helping poor people and a large loaf of bread. **Join us for Liturgy at 10:30 am,** and learn what this is all about. Everyone will get a piece of the sweet bread, but whoever finds the coin in his/hers will be considered especially blessed for the coming year.

Order for Holy Communion

Members of the Orthodox Church age seven and above must prepare for Holy Communion with a recent confession, prayer, fasting from all food and drink from midnight (unless a medical condition preclude it), being in church *before* the Epistle and Gospel readings, and being at peace with everyone.

And there went out to him all the country of Judea, and all the people of Jerusalem; and they were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. Now John was clothed with camel's hair, and had a leather girdle around his waist, and ate locusts and wild honey. And he preached, saying, "After me comes He Who is mightier than I, the thong of Whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. I have baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

Until then, fasting is suspended—even on Wednesdays and Fridays. Throughout this time, it is also the custom for Orthodox Christians to greet each other with: "Christ is Born!" and the response: "Glorify Him!"




