Today, the Church commemorates the 630 holy and God-bearing Fathers of the Fourth Ecumenical Council, which convened in the city of Chalcedon in 451. They affirmed and articulated the received, Apostolic Faith in opposition to the dual heresies promulgated by Nestorius and Eutyches.

The Bible reading dedicated to this commemoration is from the Gospel of Matthew 5.14-19, from



a segment known as the "Sermon on the Mount." This Gospel reading contains three central messages:

- 1. The disciples are to be "the light of the world."
- 2. Christ did not come "to abolish the law and the prophets, but to fulfil them."
- 3. The importance of combining practice with teaching, "he who does and teaches shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven."

LITURGY VARIATIONS

3RD ANTIPHON: TROPARION OF THE RESURRECTION (TONE 2)

When Thou didst submit Thyself unto death, O Thou deathless and immortal One, then Thou didst destroy hell with Thy Godly power. And when Thou didst raise the dead from beneath the earth, all the powers of Heaven did cry aloud unto Thee: O Christ, Thou Giver of life, glory to Thee.

Members of the Orthodox Church age seven and above must prepare for Holy Communion with a recent confession, prayer, fasting from all food and drink from midnight (unless a medical condition preclude it), being in church *before* the Epistle and Gospel readings, and being at peace with everyone.

Reading from St. Paul's Epistle to Titus (3.8-15; Holy Fathers)

TITUS, MY SON, the saying is sure. I desire you to insist on these things, so that those who have believed in God may be careful to apply themselves to good deeds; these are excellent and profitable to men. But avoid stupid controversies, genealogies, dissensions, and quarrels over the law, for they are unprofitable and futile. As for a man who is factious, after admonishing him once or twice, have nothing more to do with him, knowing that such a person is perverted and sinful; he is self-condemned.

When I send Artemas or Tychicos to you, do your best to come to me at Nicopolis, for I have decided to spend the winter there. Do your best to speed Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their way; see that they lack nothing. And let our people learn to apply themselves to good deeds, so as to help cases of urgent need, and not to be unfruitful.

All who are with me send greetings to you. Greet those who love us in the faith.

Grace be with you all. Amen.

Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew (5.14-19; Holy Fathers)

THE LORD SAID TO HIS DISCIPLES: "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a bushel, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father Who is in heaven.
