



Saints—i.e., holy people—live among us, in our own, challenging times. One of them was Elder Sophrony (Sakharov) of Essex, who was canonized just five years ago. The following is an excerpt from his book, *His Life is Mine*.

تذكار القديس نسطر الشهيد

We shall not care what people think of us, or how they treat us. We shall cease to be afraid of falling out of favour. We shall love our fellow men without thought of whether they love us. Christ gave us the commandment to love others, but did not make it a condition of salvation that they should love us. Indeed, we may positively be disliked for independence of spirit.



It is essential in these days to be able to protect ourselves from the

influence of those with whom we come in contact. Otherwise we risk losing both faith and prayer. Let the whole world dismiss us as unworthy of attention, trust or respect – it will not matter provided that the Lord accept us. And vice versa: it will profit us nothing if the whole world thinks well of us and sings our praises, if the Lord declines to abide with us. This is only a fragment of the freedom Christ meant when He said, 'Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free' (John 8.32). Our sole care will be to continue in the word of Christ, to become His disciples and cease to be servants of sin.

Order for Holy Communion

Members of the Orthodox Church age seven and above must prepare for Holy Communion with a recent confession, prayer, fasting from all food and drink from midnight (unless a medical condition preclude it), being in church *before* the Epistle and Gospel readings, and being at peace with everyone.

Prokeimenon (Psalm 32.22, 1 LXX; Tone 1) بروكيمنون (مزمور 32.22، 1؛ اللحن الاول)

Let your mercy, O Lord, be upon us.

Verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous.

From St. Paul's 2nd Epistle to the Corinthians (9.6-11; 18th Sunday)

BRETHREN, he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one must do as he has made up his mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance, so that you may always have enough of everything and may provide in abundance for every good work. As it is written, "He scatters abroad, He gives to the poor; his righteousness endures forever." He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your resources and increase the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way for great generosity, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God.

Holy Gospel according to St. Luke (8.41-56; 7th Sunday Luke)

AT THAT TIME, there came to Jesus a man named Jairus, who was a ruler of the synagogue; and falling at Jesus' feet, he besought Him to come to his house, for he had an only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she was dying.

As Jesus went, the people pressed round Him. And a woman who had had a flow of blood for twelve years, and had spent all her living upon physicians, and could not be healed by any one, came up behind Him, and touched the fringe of His garment; and immediately her flow of blood ceased. And Jesus said, "Who was it that touched me?" مِنْ بِشارَةِ القِدّيسِ لوقا الإنْجيلِيِّ البَشيرِ والتلْميذِ الطاهِر (8.41–56؛ للأحد السابع من لوقا)

في ذَلِكَ الزَّمانِ، دَنا إلى يَسوعَ إِنْسانٌ اسْمُهُ يايِرُسَ، وهُوَ رَئِيسٌ لِلْمَجْمَعِ، وَحَرَّ عِنْدَ قَدَمَيْ يَسوعَ، وطَلَبَ إلَيْهِ أَنْ يَدْخُلَ إلى بَيْتِهِ. لأَنَّ لَهُ ابْنَةَ وَحيدَةً لَهَا نَحْوَ اثْنَتَى عَشْرَةَ سَنَةً قَدْ أَشْرَفَتْ على الموْتِ.

وبيْنَمَا هُوَ مُنْطَلِقٌ، كانَ الجُموعُ يَرْحَمُونَهُ. وإنَّ امْرأَةً كِمَا نَرْفُ دَمٍ مُنْذُ اثْنَتَيْ عَشْرَةَ سَنَةً، وكانَتْ قَدْ أَنفَقَتْ مَعيشَتَها كُلَّها على الأطِبَّاءِ ولَمْ يَسْتَطِعْ أَحَدٌ أَنْ يَشفِيَها. دَنَتْ مِنْ حَلْفِهِ وَمَسَّتْ هُدْبَ ثَوْبِهِ، ولِلْوَقْتِ وَقَفَ نَرْفُ دَمِها. فقالَ يَسوعُ: "مَنْ لَمَسَنِي؟" وإذْ أَنْكَرَ جَميعُهُم، قالَ بُطْرُسُ والذينَ مَعَهُ: you, and you say, "Who touched me?" But Jesus said, "Someone touched me; for I perceive that power has gone forth from me." And when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling, and falling down before Him declared in the presence of all the people why she had touched Him, and how she had been immediately healed. And Jesus said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace."

While Jesus was speaking, a man from the ruler's house came and said, "Your daughter is dead; do not trouble the Teacher any more." But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she shall be well." And when Jesus came to the house, He permitted no one to enter with Him, except Peter and James and John, and the father and mother of the child. And all were weeping and bewailing her; but Jesus said, "Do not weep. For she is not dead but sleeping." And they laughed at Him, knowing that she was dead. But taking her by the hand Jesus called, saying, "Child, arise." And her spirit returned, and she got up at once; and Jesus directed that something should be given her to eat. And her parents were amazed; but He charged them to tell no one what had happened.

وفيما هُوَ يَتَكَلَّمُ، جاءَ واحِدٌ مِنْ ذَوِي رَئِيسِ المِجْمعِ وقالَ لَهُ: "إِنَّ ابْنَتَكَ قَدْ ماتَتْ، فلا تُتْعِبِ الْمُعَلِّم." فَسَمِعَ يسوعُ، فأَجابَهُ قائِلاً: "لا تَخَفْ. آمِنْ فَقَطْ فَتَبْراً هِيَ." وَلَمَّا دَخَلَ البَيْتَ، لَمَ يَدَعْ أَحَداً يَدْخُلُ إِلاّ بُطْرُسَ، وَيَعْقوبَ، ويُوحَنَّا وأَبَا الصَبِيَّةِ وأُمَّهَا. وكانَ الجَميعُ يَبْكُونَ ويَلْطِمُونَ علَيْهَا. فقالَ فَمُ: "لا تَبْكُوا. إلَّمَا لَمَ تَمُتْ ولكَنَّها نائِمَةٌ." فَضَحِكُوا عَلَيْهِ لِعِلْمِهِمْ بأَهَا قَدْ ماتَتْ. فأَمْسَكَ بِيَدِها ونادَى قائلاً: "يا صَبِيَّةُ قُومِي." فَرَجَعَتْ رُوحُها وقامَتْ في الحالِ. فأَمَرَ أَنْ تُعْطَى لِتأْكُلَ. فَدَهِشَ أبَوَاها، فأَوْصاهُمَا أَنْ لا يَقولا لأَحَدٍ ما جَرَى.
