Order for Holy Communion

Members of the Orthodox Church age seven and above must prepare for Holy Communion with a recent confession, prayer, fasting from all food and drink from midnight (unless a medical condition preclude it), being in church before the Epistle and Gospel readings, and being at peace with everyone.

TEACHERS THEN CHILDREN going to church school should come down the center aisle first. (Small children may need to be assisted by their parents.)

ALL OTHERS should wait until an usher dismisses your row from the center aisle. Then return to your place by a side aisle for the prayers of thanksgiving and the final blessing and dismissal. Please let choir members pass when they come down for Communion.

Intercede with Christ God for us and for all who honor Thee.

The verity of your actions revealed you to your flock, a rule of faith, an icon of mildness, and teacher of abstinence, O Father Bishop Nicholas; wherefore by humility you have achieved exaltation and by poverty richness. Kontakion for the Sunday of Last Judgement (Tone 1)

THE SCRIPTURE LESSONS

Prokeimenon (Psalm 117.14, 18 LXX; Tone 2)

The Lord is my strength and my song.

Verse: The Lord has chastened me sorely.

From Paul's 1st Epistle to the Corinthians (8.8-9.2; Sunday of the Last Judgement)

BRETHREN, food will not commend us to God. We are no worse off if we do not eat, and no better off if we do. Only take care, lest this liberty of yours somehow become a stumbling block to the weak. For if anyone sees you—a man of knowledge—at table in an idol's temple, might he not be encouraged, if his conscience is weak, to eat food offered to idols? And so by your knowledge this weak man is destroyed, the brother for whom Christ died. Thus, sinning against your brethren and wounding their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ. Therefore, if food is a cause of my brother's falling, I will never eat meat, lest I cause my brother to fall. Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord? Are not you my workmanship in the Lord? If to others I am not an apostle, at least I am to you; for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord.

Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew (25.31-46; Sunday of the Last Judgement)

THE LORD SAID, "When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. Before Him will be gathered all the nations, and He will separate them one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and He will place the sheep at His right hand, but the goats at the left. يا إحْوَةُ، إنَّ الطَّعامَ لا يُفَرِّبُنا إلى الله، لأنَّا إنْ أَكلْنا لا نَزِيدُ وإنْ لَمَ نَأْكُلْ لا نَنْقُصُ. ولَكْنِ انْظُرُوا أَنْ لا يَكونَ سُلْطانُكُمْ هذا مَعْثَرَةً للضُّعَفَاءِ. لأنَّهُ إنْ رَآكَ أَحَدٌ يا مَنْ لَهُ العِلْمُ مُتَّكِئاً في بيتِ الأَوْثانِ، أفَلا يَتَقوَّى ضَمِيرُهُ، وهو ضَعيفٌ، على أكلِ ذبائح الأَوْثانِ. فَيَهلِكَ بسبَبِ عِلْمِكَ الأَحُ الصَّعِيفُ الذي مات المسِيحُ لأجلِهِ؟ وهكَذا إذْ تُخْطِئونَ إلى الإحْوَةِ وبَحَرَحُونَ ضَمائِرَهُمْ، وهِيَ ضَعِيفَةٌ، إنَّا تُخْطِئونَ إلى الإحْوَةِ فَلِذلِكَ إِنْ كَانَ الطَّعامُ يُشَكِّكُ أَخي، فَلا آتُكُلُ لَماً إلى الأبَدِ لقَلاً أُشَكِكَ أَخي. ألَسْتُ أنا رَسولاً؟ ألَسْتُ أنا حُرًاً؟ إذا رَيتُ يسوعَ المسيحِ رَبَّنَا؟ ألَسْتُ أنا رَسولاً؟ ألَسْتُ أنا حُرَّا؟ وإنْ لَمْ أَكُنْ رسولاً إلى آحَرِينَ، فإليّ رَسولاً إلى يُحْمَلي في الرَّبِ؟ رِسَالتي هوَ أَنْتُمْ في الرَّبِ.

مِنْ بِشارَةِ القِدّيسِ مَتّى الإنْجيلِيِّ البَشيرِ والتلْميذِ الطاهِر (٢٥,٣١-٤٦؛ لأحَدِ الدينونة)

قالَ الرَّبُّ: مَتى جاءَ ابْنُ البَشَرِ في مُجْدِهِ وجميعُ الملائكةِ القِدّيسينَ مَعَهُ، فَحِينئِذٍ يَجَلِسُ على عَرشِ مَجْدِهِ. وتُجُمَعُ إليهِ كُلُّ الأُمَمِ، فَيُمَيِّزُ بَعضَهُمْ مِنْ بَعضٍ، كما يُمَيِّزُ الراعي الخِرافَ منَ الجداءِ. ويُقيمُ الخِرافَ عَنْ يَمِينِهِ والجِداءَ عَنْ يَسارِهِ. حينَئِذٍ King will say to those at His right hand, 'Come, O blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave Me food, I was thirsty and you gave Me drink. I was a stranger and you welcomed Me, I was naked and you clothed Me, I was sick and you visited Me, I was in prison and vou came to Me.' Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry and feed Thee, or thirsty and give Thee drink? And when did we see Thee a stranger and welcome Thee, or naked and clothe Thee? And when did we see Thee sick or in prison and visit Thee?' And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.' Then He will say to those at his left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave Me no food, I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome Me, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.' Then they also will answer. 'Lord. when did we see Thee hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to Thee?' Then He will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to Me.' And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."



2025 LENTEN SERVICES at the Cathedral

In <u>Addition</u> to the regular, weekly services: Saturday Vespers, 6 p.m. Sunday Matins: 9:15 a.m. • Sunday Divine Liturgy: 10:30 a.m.

Lent starts with Forgiveness — We start Lent at 6:30 p.m. Sunday, March 2. We celebrate the rite of mutual forgiveness as we start the journey to the Resurrection.

Mondays — On Mondays in Lent we will serve Great Compline at 6:30 p.m.

- **The first week of Lent**, Great Compline is served on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday nights, with portions of the Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete.
- On March 24 we will instead celebrate the Vespers for the Annunciation.

Wednesdays — Join us at **6:30 p.m. for the Presanctified Liturgy**. Fast from all food and drink from *at least* noon in preparation for Holy Communion. Bring one Lenten item to share for a potluck after Liturgy. (Various Cathedral organizations might host dinner some weeks—to be announced). A short spiritual discussion will follow.

Fridays — Little Compline with the Akathist Hymn to the Theotokos at 6:30 p.m.

• **On April 11**, we serve the Little Compline with the Canon of Lazarus.

Saturdays — We serve the Liturgy each Saturday morning in Lent. See the calendar for the specific times; some Saturdays the Liturgy will be early, before FOCUS.

• The first Saturday Morning of Lent, March 8, we serve the Liturgy at 7 am in commemoration of St. Theodore and the miracle of the boiled wheat, including another memorial for All Souls: You may bring koliva and a list of the names of your departed to be remembered.


